RE-CREATION

Seeley D. Kinne

Were the Apostle writing by the Spirit in our day, he would say the coming into the state, sphere and realm of Christ Jesus is not effected by some formula of water baptism, or particular sacramental view, or doctrinal tenet, or governmental order, or any outward thing whatsoever. Entrance into the Christ state of Divine indwelling and Holy Spirit control is by the miracle-working power of Christ, recreating one into a new creature or creation. "For what counts is neither circumcision nor uncircumcision. It is the new creation." (Moffatt) Gal. 6:15; 2 Cor. 5:17.

To create is defined, "To bring into existence." To recreate is "To create anew." To restore to the original state or higher. "The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a life giving Spirit." 1 Cor. 15:45.

The processes, methods and means of recreation are of several kinds and ways of applying divine power. The first step in creation or recreation is always the divine fiat, the uttered Word of God. When God speaks, His Word is so infinitely powerful it immediately sets into action the creating impulse. This was Christ's way. "He sent forth His Word and healed them." He said in the Word, for He was the WORD, "I will: be thou clean." "Stretch forth thine hand." "Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity." "Arise," etc. So at creation, He spoke, "Let there be" The Word of God is the underlying creative cause of the great events of Scripture record.

It is high time-yea, it is the Divine design that the "Ministry of the Word," in recreating power should be restored to the Church. It is the true Gospel, the unadulterated Gospel. "If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God," the Logos, the Word. Acts 6:4; 1 Pet. 4:10,11.

When the Word of God comes forth in the Holy Spirit, it has a mighty, cleansing, transforming, recreating power. It is described in Eph. 5:26, thus, "That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of the water by the Word." These processes are effectual in the work of recreating the character, by taking away the sharp corners, weaknesses, excesses, bents and turns of disposition, subduing, bringing down and changing all kinds of attitudes and tendencies, stilling the noisy tongue, removing the sting of an unkind reply, accusing or taking up a reproach, taking away rough ways and words, and many undesirable ways and traits, and then imparting the precious graces of the Spirit and making humble, tender, gentle, pitiful, sweet, affable, obliging. This is the work of character bui'ding and recreation so essential and greatly needed, and yet so greatly neglected.

There is not and cannot be any such thing as entering into the perfection state, the greater privileges of the incoming dispensation, without entering heartily into the recreating processes of crucifixion, transformation, and character overhauling and rebuilding by the application of the Word of Christ. You must enter the School of the Holy Spirit, come under the operating power of the Word, or be left out. There is no other way.

There are other methods and processes through which the recreating power of the Lord operates. In the Scripture they are described and illustrated by natural activities as, fuller's soap, refining gold, fanning chaff, the scourge and the cross of Christ. Applied by the Spirit these result in miraculous character transformations. They are the divinely provided means of becoming the Sons of God, soldiers in the army of the Lord and those other states belonging to the transition period.

LATTER RAIN WORKS

We are now living in the "Period of the Great Restoration." In this time there happens many notable and great events, especially as this is in Scripture called the Time of the End. It is the Transition time, the closing of past dispensations, or their converging into the New Age. It is the creation or recreation of dispensations by Jesus Christ, as in Heb. 1:2, "By whom He made the ages." "The ends of the ages are upon us," for recreation or new adjustment-a new age.

The upward trend is begun. The ascent of restoration and recreation will only end when He says, "Behold, I make all things new." A new Heaven, a new earth, new dispositioned animals, a restored race of man. RECREATION! "Nothing shall hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain." Isa. 11:4-9.

The above described works of experience pertain to the Latter Rain in its various impartations which are wonderful and glorious indeed. But they cannot come upon unprepared people. You must get into the preparatory schooling if you would be qualified and receive the Latter Rain inundation.

There is a state or condition, a perfection of being in the three natures of man, "Spirits of just men made perfect." This state of entire recreation and restoration of man to his original wholeness, is the redemption right procured by Jesus Christ in His death on the cross. It has not hitherto been fully understood and appropriated by the faith of men. But now in a dispention of fulness of times; God has ordained that some must enter into His rest, cease from their independent living, and come to live in God and dwell in Him. This is the great Mystery of Christ in you. This is RECREATION in its fuller sense-Redemption of Spirit, soul and body.

EXPERIMENTAL

Approach to the new states and experiences of an opening dispensation such as Intervention, Sons of God, Soldiers or Officers in the Army of God, Perfection, Latter Rain, Over-

comers, Bride of Christ, Manchild, are filled with marvelous manifestations of God's power and grace. These several states seem to be arranged in Divine wisdom as degrees of an ascending scale, or a series of states approaching consummation.

Whoever passes through this liberation can scarce ever be enticed again into the o'd slavery to appetites, desires and selfish natural motions.

I promised to preach for a Bro. Sosa on Saturday night. The Lord spoke to me that I was to go with Bro. Davis to Jamaica, and that I should have asked Him before promising. We went to a wedding in the afternoon. As I sat there during the ceremony a warm wave of Divine power came upon me and settled in my abdomen. I was sensible of it for hours. The next time I preached I was mightily wrought upon.

A message was spoken to me at the meeting at Jamaica, "To the faithful the Lord will give overcoming. There will come a time when you will exercise all these things and have a greater ministry and glorify the Lord. In a little while your body will be free from age and infirmity, renewed (a redemption body) to withstand persecution. In a very short time my children will go forth in great power in the name of Jesus. Run the race with patience. Let nothing stand in the way of going into the greater ministry to which you are cal'ed and for which you are being prepared,"
