The Transition from the Natural to the Supernatural

"The voice said, Cry. And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh is grass, and all the goodliness thereof is as the flower of the field: The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the Lord bloweth upon it: surely the people is grass," (Isa. 40:6-7).

In these glorious end time days the Lord is blowing upon the soulish, fleshly, or natural mind and withering it as grass burned in the sun, that He may bring forth the spiritual or supernatural mind, which proceeds, not from the human intellect, but from the heart of God.

The transition from the natural to the supernatural is manifested by various operations of the Spirit in different pegrees in the several members of the Body of Christ according to the yieldedness of the individual heart.

In this transitional state, we discover nine fundamental gifts, usually called gifts of the Spirit, together with a plurality of operations and manifestations of the Spirit and different kinds of ministries, (I Cor. 12: 4-11).

Many of God's dear saints are being lifted into a new realm of the Spirit. This is manifested to the individual by a deeper sense of the presence of God, by a reverence and godly fear, heretofore unknown, by a deeper sense of love and greater manifestation of joy.

Some describe this new spiritual attainment as an inner sensible burning, others as an inner bubbling, and still others as joybells ringing. It is very gracious and glorious.

Outwardly, it is manifested by the clapping of the hands, prostrations, spiritual inebriation, the holy dance, the victory march, running, leaping, spiritual songs and many other sensible manifestations. Tongues, interpretation, prophecy, revelation and Word of Wisdom are very much in evidence. Other gifts, operations and ministries are seen in lesser degrees.

A revelation of the meaning of "Forward Move," was recently given, which was as follows: The Forward Move is a constantly moving forward in the Spirit toward the final consummation and includes the restoration of all that was lost in Adam's fall, including the New Testament Church."

One very precious operation of the Spirit in our midst is the solution of problems and the answer to difficult questions thro the exercise of spiritual gifts and which could not be solved and answered by the natural mind. Recently a guest in the school asked: "Why are there so many religious sects and denominations?" And immediately the following message came forth: "I say unto you, the reason there are so many religious sects and denominations, is because My people have not come up into the power of My Spirit." People in the same spiritual realm see, as it were, eye to eye.

Another very recent prophetical message was, in substance, as follows, "The Manchild, (Rev. 12), is being formed in the Body, the Church. The quickening of the child is already being felt by the Church." This Manchild is identified as the Bride or Sons of God, (Rom. 8:14), and has not yet been manifested, (Rom. 8:19). The birth of the Manchild is analogous to the natural birth. First the head presents, then the shoulders, and the rest of the body is a rapid transit to a new realm or sphere.
