

INTERVENTION JUDGMENT (THIRD SERIES)

I God's Restoration Program

1. God has designed the whole plan of the world's conduct and history from creation to consummation. "Known unto God are all His works from the beginning of the world." "And hath determined the times before appointed." Acts 15:18; 17:26.

2. Part of this Divine design is a purpose to restore the physical earth, the animals, and the race of man, to original wholeness, perfection, health and holiness. To accomplish this restoration, Jesus Christ, "God of the ages," has appointed a 1,000 year period.

3. In closing of past ages and opening of coming ones, these ages overlap, forming what may be termed Transition. In this period there comes a great readjustment of affairs. Many matters of great moment make up the Divine business of this time.

4. The extent and completeness of this renovation surpasses apprehension. Government, religion and every phase of man's earth existence, physical, moral and spiritual, are to be recovered, readjusted and put on a sound righteous and heavenly basis.

II The Full Cups

1. Great, terrible and long continued have been the wickedness and crimes of the Gentile era. The cup of their iniquity is full, therefore, the cup of God's wrath is full.

2. Oh! the arrogance, the audacity, the pride, the haughtiness, the intrusion, the disobedience, the high-handed appropriation of My rights, saith the Lord. "God made man upright, but he hath sought many inventions.

3. Those were terrible intrusions, when some 300 years after Christ, He was deposed by His ministry and crowded out of that sovereign intervention as Head of the Church. This substitution of man's control and usurpation of Christ's Headship was an audacious, arrogant, assumption of Divine prerogatives. It changed the Church from a Divine, living, powerful organism of God, to a dead human machine.

4. The rebellious crime that took the innocent Christ, Creator and Son of God, and professed to condemn and crucify Him by His own law, has no parallel in history.

5. By the same wicked stolen powers have the apostles, prophets and messengers of Christ, men who were in the power of God, been martyred and persecuted, upwards of one hundred

million of them. They were burned, fed to wild beasts, flayed and tortured by the most cruel inventions that could be devised.

6. And even today, "He that departeth from iniquity maketh himself a prey." Many who call themselves Christians; in their pride and arrogance, disdain, despise and persecute those who stand for the power of God.

7. So-called revivals are promoted by neglect and rejection of the power of God and substituting all sorts of human inventions and sometimes false powers.

8. There is a doing away with the prophetic word of God and substituting man's preaching, legislation and regulation.

9. In all periods of earth's history, God has been rejected, neglected, and forgotten, while man in his rebellion, blasphemes and worships idols, demons, mammon, pleasure, man, and evil spirits. For their wickedness, nation after nation has come under the wrath of God and been destroyed.

10. By many inventions, the elements and powers of nature have been harnessed. Designing men have built colossal fortunes out of these gifts of nature, while they were protected by government and financial systems which favor the few and oppress the masses.

11. Church men have substituted modernism and evolution—other names for the denial of the Word of God—for Christ and the Bible. Doctors and drugs take the place of the healing virtue of God. Courts by false pleading and practice, become instruments of injustice. Natural learning and abilities displace the gifts and power of the Spirit.

12. Morals have gone away backward. Covetousness, stealing, murder, suicide, robbery, divorce, fornication and uncleanness, abound.

13. Therefore, saith Jehovah, the most High God, for these great crimes of Gentile nations, I will be avenged. I will destroy these nations. I will cause them to destroy one another.

III Intervention Over the Nations

1. One form of Intervention is God's sovereign hand operating through His determinate prophetic word among the nations, preparing to take over the government of the world. "Therefore have I hewed them by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth." Hosea 6:5.

2. By the prophetic word the ancient nations were destroyed. The Lord's Intervention was effective through His prophets. But they also had some prophecies concerning the nations of

today. These are now to be fulfilled. But these prophecies concerning today were only outlines. More minute prophecies of details were left to be spoken by a prophetic company or army of these last days. This army is now forming.

3. The Intervention army of God-controlled prophets, is possessed and directed by the Holy Spirit. They speak by the Spirit the determinate word of God, which shall step by step restore earth to original completeness, sound and holy. This prophetic army, which is to deal with the nations, and its activities, is described in Joel 2:1-17; Isa. 13:2-9.

IV Design of these Teachings

1. The principle design of the Lord in giving Intervention teachings is to open the understanding of His people that they may know that—

2. There is an attitude of the Lord toward His people which is properly called Intervention. This has been obscured or lost sight of.

3. This sovereign Divine attitude is an expression of the benevolence of God toward His people. The basis of its operation is in the Atonement of Jesus Christ, which is the greatest Intervention of all time, and is above and superior to all of man's seeking and asking.

4. That this sovereign Intervention activity of God is available and now being restored to the people of God.

5. It is not limitation of privilege, but vastly multiplies and enhances opportunities; for it lifts man from poverty into God's abundance.

6. To become possessor of its privileges one needs but to exchange the finite creature vision, to the Infinite Creator's far sight, which is accomplished by aid of the Spirit and transfer of effort from man's feeble self-reliance to an acceptance of and conformity to God's plans for individual attainment. This Divine personal appropriation is so gracious and rich that it will fill all capacity, natural and enlarged, to the running over of the vessel.

DEVOTION

Devotion is the blending of vehement, arduous, passionate zeal, with love, abandonment, worship and adoration. Devotion to Christ of so rare dimensions is the basis of the human state, upon which Intervention is bestowed. It is the sum of repentance, consecration, yieldedness and self-sacrifice; the immolation of natural ambitions, plans, hopes, and personal activities not originating in God. It calls for the presenting of all our faculties to God

as a living sacrifice, and becoming His bond slave.

Abdication of personal self-control in so full a degree, has been found out or attained only by a few. In the face of this truth the sun of human hopes appears to be setting. But once having passed through so straight a gate, the pastime of chasing Life's illusive phantom bubbles loses its charm. The Divine bestowal of true riches is so elaborate and abundant, that he who thought all lost, is amazed at the vastness of a new found domain and the riches of Christ, surpassing all previous apprehension. "As having nothing and yet possessing all things." 2 Cor. 6:10.

Devotion means all that is implied in the other terms of sacrifice. Consecration may be cold and legal. Abandonment may come through pressure. Yieldedness may follow severe chastening. But Devotion is glad joyous delight in the will of God, be it pain or pleasure, humbling or exalting. It is the wealth of heart love poured out at the Master's feet.

So touched is the heart of the Infinite by such zeal and devotion, scarcely anything could be withheld. Intervention over a devoted life is the very delight of God. Miracle working power He wants to give. His nature is intensely responsive to devoted creatures—His the response of the Great Almighty. *S. Kinne*
