Intervention Review

Some sixteen months past, the Lord began giving intervention teachings. A hearty approval has been given by most all that they were from God.

But the common habit was followed by many: Read, approve, accept and preserve for future reference. Then neglect, forget and fail to

experimentally enter into them.

Some have received one or several of the Lord's acts of intervention and have been greatly delighted with their richness. A number have caught a vision of an intervention state, and have earnestly sought the Lord and made progress toward an entire and glad "Devotion," which is a proper condition for God to possess and control one. When one does make this complete and permanent sacrifice of all to God in glad "Devotion," He begins to taste the miracle of Divine control and the intervention state. This is the way into an Apostolic state and the miracle realm. have entered initiatory stages of this state and are passing more and more into God's possession. Satisfaction and delight are inexpressible.

Intervention teachings were not given merely to enable one to recognize and be thankful for Intervention acts of God, that often are so delightfully sprinkled along the path of earth journeyings. But rather their purpose is to rediscover long lost privileges, to unveil an Apostolic state, to come into a spiritual plane of life in the Spirit in the heavenlies, where man ceases from his own works and enters a Human natural activity is rest therefrom. laid down. The planning or iniatory now arises no longer from man but originates in God by the movings of the Holy Spirit. Execution of these plans is God working through His servants.

Entering this state a quieting, soothing balm of the Spirit is difussed throughout one's being, imparting an indescribably sweet sense of rest.

One seems enfolded in the arms of the Almighty. Those who enter this relationship become God's peculiar treasure, over whom He jealously watches to guard from harm and use to His glory.

Intervention and the Cross

In order that the nature may be changed from its independent action, to action by the movings of the Holy Ghost and that without hindrance, it is necessary that human nature be crucified. This crucifixion is brought about by Divine application of the cross. A cross is produced by the Lord placing some trial, affliction, means of suffering, sorrow or adverse circumstance in the path of life.

To a timid, retiring one it is a cross to be pushed into public activity. To an ambitious, active person, to be made to sit down and wait is a cross. To rejoice in tribulation is crucifying. Doing pennance or self-made suffering is not taking the cross given by the Lord, and

does not crucify.

To arrive at an Intervention state one must take the cross that is presented to him by the Spirit. Thus bearing the cross, recreating power comes upon the several departments of

The cross upon the will may deprive of what is strongly one's choice. God may require that which we do not like to do or accept. He will bring to a point of making a living sacrifice, a whole burnt offering. The Spirit applies the cross till "Devotion" becomes a willing, glad and whole hearted choice.

The cross upon the mind means, "When a man thinketh himself to be wise, let him become a fool, that he may be wise." That is lay down, or submit natural wit and wisdom to the Holy Spirit. "I know nothing by myself." Allow the weapons of the Spirit to attack and cast down imaginations and reasonings, till the mind is brought into captivity, obedience and control of the Holy Spirit. Its natural activities stopped, it becomes a tool for the Spirit to operate.

The heart nature fully crucified by the breaking of all its attachments, loves, and affections, now enters into the employment of the Spirit, and is by Him moved to prayer, intercession, and all kinds of both inward and outward activities in the Spirit - a new, glorious and useful occupation. Even the voluntary physical motions of the body may come into Divine control. Blessed state of Divine possession and control - Intervention - "Christ in you."
